A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF WHITMAN COUNTY, AMENDING ITS 2016-2020 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Port Commission of the Port of Whitman County previously adopted its Comprehensive Plan of 2016-2020; and

WHEREAS, the off-water development strategy of the Port for the Locust Grove Industrial Park Plat South, commonly known as Pullman Industrial Park West, expressed in the 2016-2020 plan specifies development of streets and utilities and coordination of the creation of utility construction reimbursement zone with City of Pullman; and

WHEREAS, the Port Commission wishes to amend the 2016-2020 plan to allow for surplus and sale or lease of lots located within the Pullman Industrial Park West;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF WHITMAN COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:


